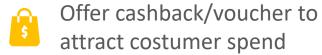

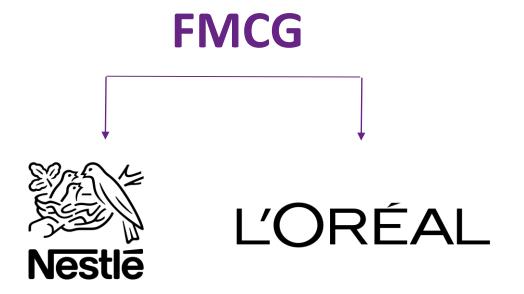

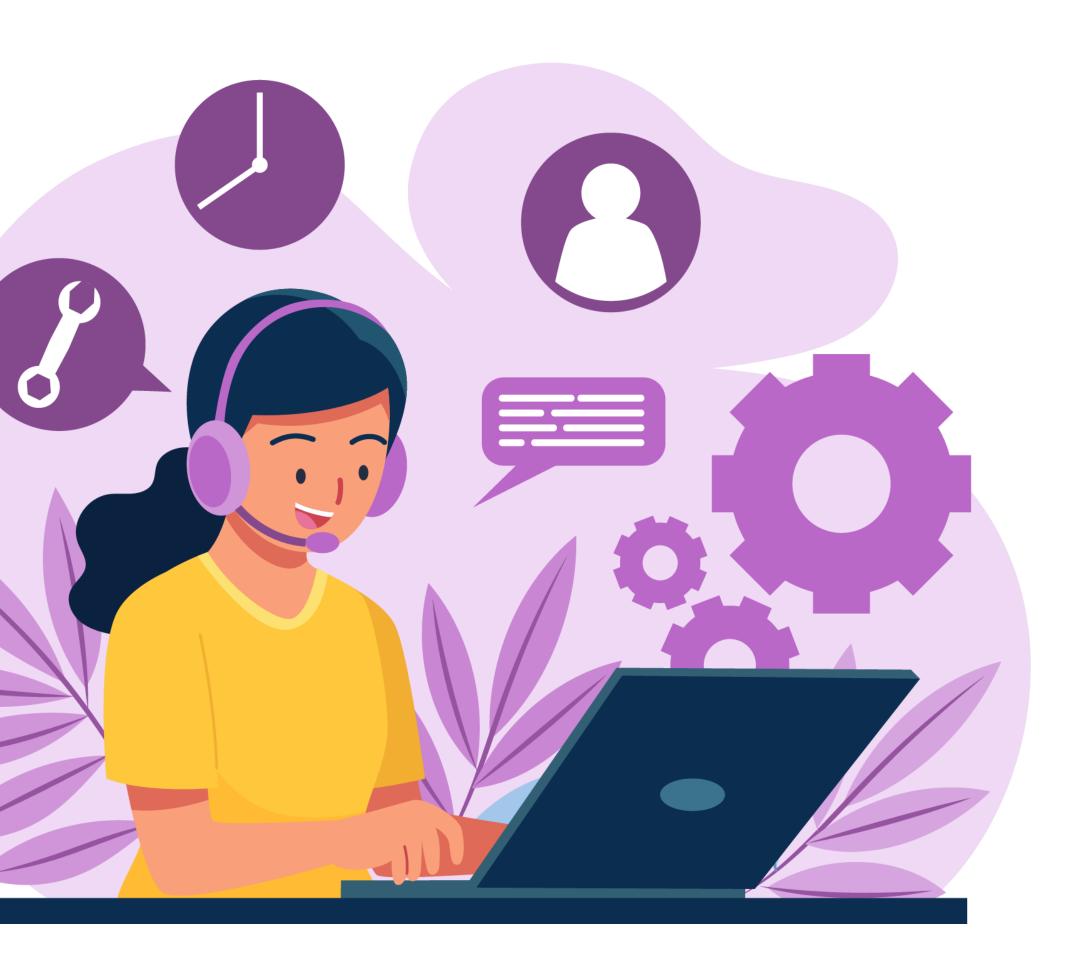

Learn policies of the store (refunds, returns and types of payment)

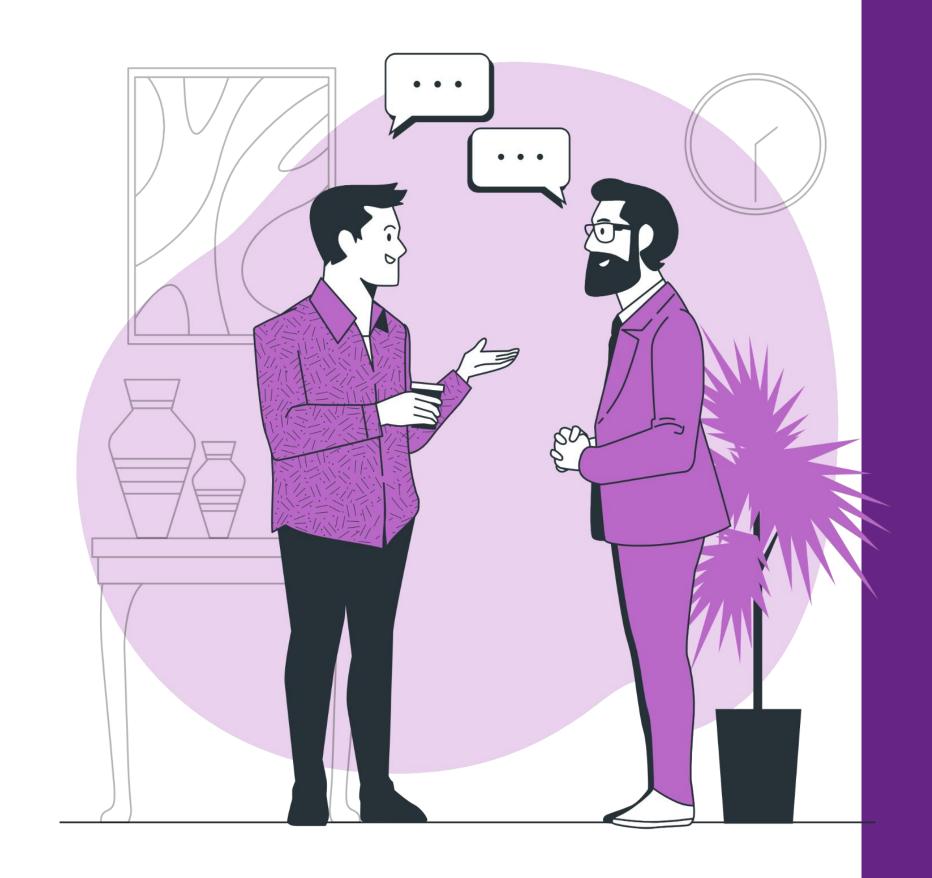
Answer to common questions

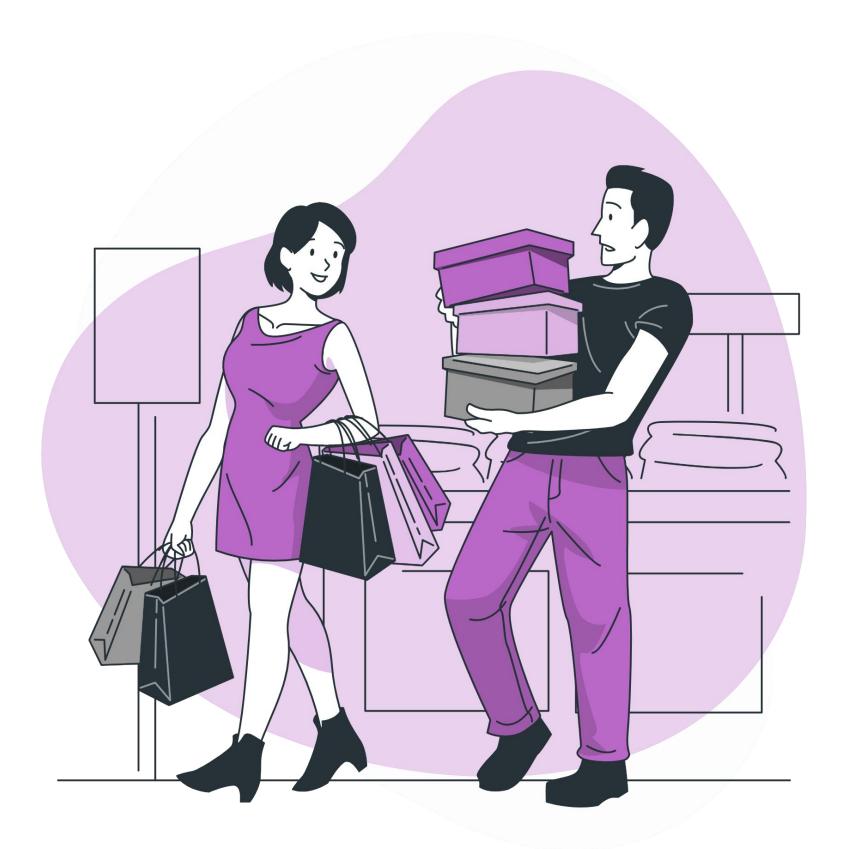
Greet customer and check in on them regularly

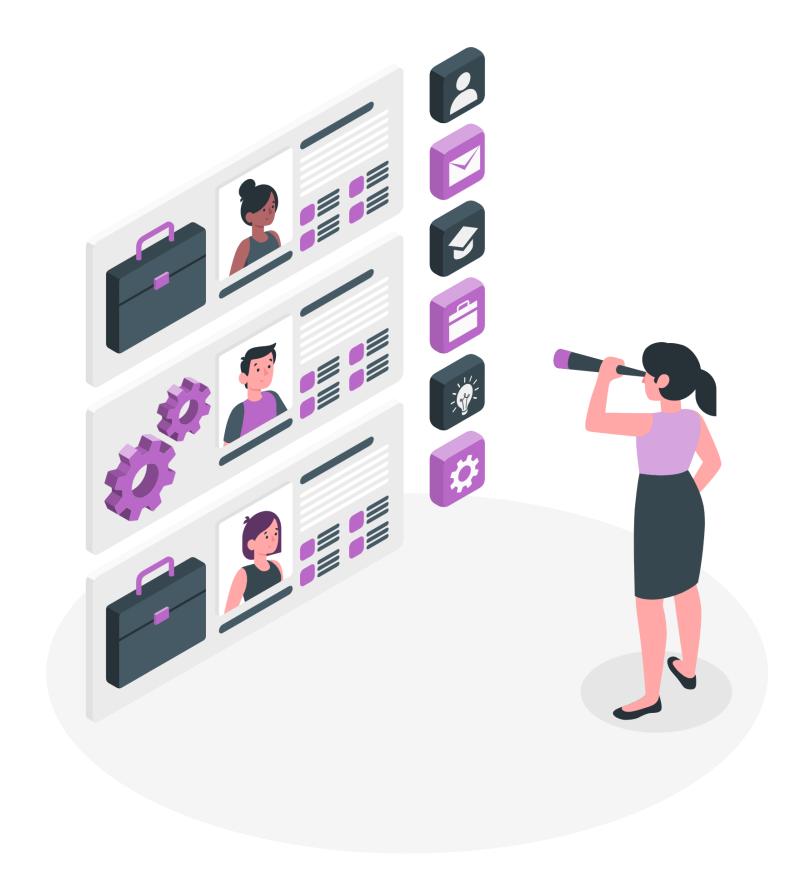
